We received your generous donation of \$20,000 representing one slice of our 64 slice CT Scanner. We have now received gifts equivalent to 47 slices or \$961,000. Thank you so much for your contribution. Your donation will be featured in both of our newspapers and is currently on our website at www.hospitalfoundationfsj.org. We are very excited about the CT Scanner campaign and are glad that so many people understand the importance to our community of this essential piece of diagnostic equipment. We hope to conclude our campaign by the middle of December and our machine is scheduled for installation by January 1.



With the use of a CT Scanner, physicians can assess acute trauma, injuries, abdominal and chest disease, cardiovascular disease and stroke damage, as well as diagnose tumors, infectious diseases, and musculoskeletal disorders. With the CT Scanner the physicians can guide biopsies and other procedures, plan surgery, and provide imaging for Oncology patients. The CT Scanner has become a widely used and fundamentally basic diagnostic tool that is needed at the Fort St. John Hospital and Health Centre.

Thank you for being a part of this initiative. The 2300 people we send to other communities each year for a CT Scanner can remain at home, safe from travel on winter roads, safe from the excruciating ambulance rides, and close to the medical staff they know and trust.
